Mayor Kalvaitis stated that it was now time for the public hearing to be held as it was advertised to be held at this time and declared the meeting open to the public. There appearing to be no one wishing to speak at this time a motion was made by Kappatos, seconded by Passio the public hearing be closed. The motion carried and a motion was made by Kappatos seconded by Passio the ordinance be adopted on second and final reading and advertised according to law. The motion carried and Mayor Kalvaitis requested a roll call vote with the following results: Ayes: White, Kappatos, Kelly & Passio. Nays: None. Absent: Moore & Root. Mayor Kalvaitis declared the ordinance adopted on second and final reading.

**ORDINANCE #13-21**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, desire to amend a portion of the Borough Code relating to Garbage and Rubbish Collection; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council find that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to amend the code; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 316, Solid Waste, article I, Sections 316-2.G and 316-2.H, of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey be and is amended as follows:

(G). All garbage, rubbish and garbage/recycling containers upon any property within the limits of the Borough not placed for collection pursuant to § 316-5 shall be stored in the side or rear yard of the property in a neat and orderly fashion and in receptacles as defined in § 316-4.

(H). All garbage, rubbish and garbage/recycling containers upon any property within the limits of the Borough not placed for collection pursuant to § 316-5 shall not be stored in the front yard of any property, with Front Yard as defined in § 395-4.B.

**DECEMBER 30, 2013**

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 316, Solid Waste, article I, Sections 316-3 shall be amended to include sections 316-3(G) and (H) which shall read as follows:

(G). Improper disposal of hypodermic needles will result in discontinuation of trash service. If a violation occurs, trash service will be discontinued until resident is enrolled into a Safe Syringe Disposal Program.

(H). Violation. Any person, firm or corporation that violates or neglects to comply with any provision of this chapter or any regulation promulgated pursuant thereto, shall, upon conviction thereof, within forty-eight (48) hours of notice, be punishable by a fine not to exceed the following amount for the following offenses:

- i. First offense: Up to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
- ii. Second offense: Up to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
- iii. Third offense and thereafter: Up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

**BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE**

Mayor Kalvaitis stated that it was now time for the public hearing to be held as it was advertised to be held at this time and declared the meeting open to the public. There appearing to be no one wishing to speak at this time a motion was made by Kappatos, seconded by Kelly the public hearing be closed. The motion carried and a motion was made by Kappatos seconded by Passio the ordinance be adopted on second and final reading and advertised according to law. The motion carried and Mayor Kalvaitis requested a roll call vote with the following results: Ayes: White, Kappatos, Kelly & Passio. Nays: None. Absent: Moore & Root. Mayor Kalvaitis declared the ordinance adopted on second and final reading.

**ORDINANCE #13-22**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, desire to amend a portion of the Borough Code relating to Zoning; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council find that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to amend the code; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 395, Zoning, Section 395-15.A(4) of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey be and is amended as follows:

(4). No person shall erect any fence with a height greater than six (6) feet without first obtaining a permit from the Construction Code Official.

**DECEMBER 30, 2013**

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 395, Zoning, Section 395-15.A, of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey be shall be amended to include sections 395-15.A(5) and 395-15.A(6) which shall read as follows:

(5). No person shall erect a fence with a height of six (6) feet or less without first obtaining a permit from the Zoning Officer. Fences placed adjacent to the sidewalk shall be installed no closer than two (2) feet from the edge of the sidewalk. A permit shall be required whether a fence is installed at a new location or replacing an existing fence. The cost of the application and permit shall total \$65.00.

(6). No personal shall install any concrete driveway, private sidewalk, steps, porch, patio, or any other flat concrete work not required to obtain a permit under the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code without first obtaining a permit from the Zoning Officer. A permit is required whether the installation is at a new location or replacing an existing installation. The cost of the application and permit for the installation of a private sidewalk and steps shall total \$25.00. The cost of the application and permit for the installation of a porch, patio, or any other flat concrete work not required to obtain a permit under the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code shall total \$50.00.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 395, Zoning, Section 395-18A. of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey be and is amended as follows:

Permit. No sign more than twenty-five (25) square feet shall be erected without a signed permit issued by the Construction Code Official. No sign that is supported by uprights or braces in or upon the ground surface and not served by an electrical circuit connected directly to the sign and is not greater than twenty-five (25) square feet in surface area (one side) and is not mounted more than six (6) feet above the ground (mounted height) shall be erected without a signed permit issued by the Zoning Officer. The cost of the application and permit shall total \$25.00.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 395, Zoning, Section 395-18.B(4), of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede shall be amended to include section 395-18.B(4)(d) which shall read as follows:

(4.) A thirty (30) day temporary sign permit issued by the construction official shall be required for any property, excluding one or two family dwellings, for a special activities event. One permit per location shall be allowed during the calendar year. All signs, banners, streamers and similar devices shall be approved by the construction official. The cost of the application and permit shall total \$25.00.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 395, Zoning, Section 395-21.C, of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede shall be amended to include section 395-21.C(4) which shall read as follows:

(4). No personal shall erect or construct any garden-type utility shed and similar structure that is 100 square feet or less of use group R-2, R-3, R-4, or R-5 and which do not contain a water, gas, oil or sewer connection without first obtaining a zoning permit issued by the Zoning Officer.

**DECEMBER 30, 2013**

The shed or structure shall be placed at a distance of at least five (5) feet from the side and rear property lines and shall not be placed closer than ten (10) feet from the street line. The cost of the application and permit shall total \$25.00.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 395, Zoning, Section 395-21.D(2) of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey be and is amended as follows:

(2). Certificate of continued occupancy. Whenever there shall occur a change of occupancy or ownership in any residential or commercial building or part thereof including a change in apartment dwelling units without a change of zoning use, a certificate of continued occupancy shall be required.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

**BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE**

**RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THAT GOVERNING BODY HAS REVIEWED  
2012 AUDIT RECOMMENDATIONS, BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE,  
COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions, and

WHEREAS, The Annual Report of Audit for the year 2012 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Municipal Clerk as per the requirements of N.J.S. 40A:5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the governing body, and

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey is authorized to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs, as per R.S. 52:27BB-34, and

WHEREAS, The Local Finance Board has promulgated a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall by resolution certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled:

WHEREAS, The members of the governing body have personally reviewed as a minimum the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled:

Recommendations as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, Such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, as per the regulations of the Local Finance Board, and

WHEREAS, All members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board, and

WHEREAS, Failure to comply with the promulgations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S.52:27BB-52-to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52-"A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office."

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Governing Body of the Borough of Runnemede, hereby states that it has complied with the promulgation of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey dated July 30, 1968 and does hereby submit a certified copy of this resolution and the required affidavit to said Board to show evidence of said compliance.
